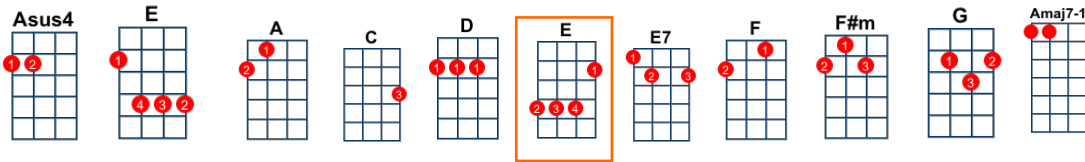


Lazy Sunday Afternoon key:A, artist:Small Faces
