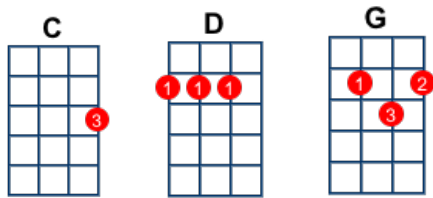


Seaside Shuffle - Terry Dactyl and the Dinosaurs
