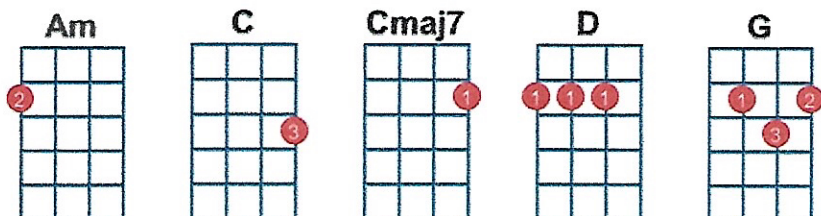


# Sloop John B - artist: The Beach Boys
