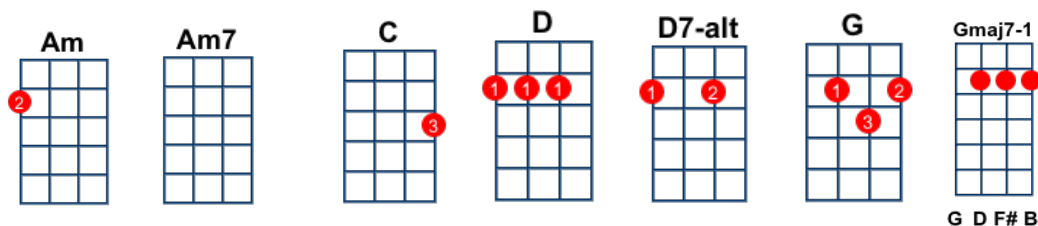


Peacemaker by Albert Hammond
